Ordinance 2016 – 27

An Ordinance Establishing the 2016 ZIKA GRANT (ISDH)

Whereas, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention has allocated funding in the form of a grant to various states and local governments in an effort to prevent, mitigate, and fight the Zika virus; and

Whereas, the Montgomery County Health Department applied for and was awarded, by the Indiana State Department of Health (“ISDH”), a grant for the intended purpose of building a vector control capacity in the County to fight the Zika virus; and

Whereas, the Zika Grant issued by the ISDH is conditioned upon the County’s fulfillment of the duties, obligations, and requirements detailed in the “Grant Agreement.” This Agreement is attached as Exhibit A; and

Whereas, the Montgomery County Health Department and the Board of Commissioners reviewed these terms and believe it is in the best interest of Montgomery County and its citizens to perform these duties and participate in this grant; and

Whereas, the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners finds that it is in the best interest of the County, and its citizens, to establish a fund in order to capture the receipt of these monies, and this fund shall be named the “2016 Zika Grant Fund.”

Therefore, it is ordained that a new section, Section 35.95, is hereby added to the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances establishing the 2016 Zika Grant Fund. And this section shall read as follows:

“ § 35.95 2016 ZIKA GRANT FUND

(A) *Source of Funds.* The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the 2016 Zika Grant Fund. The funds shall consist of grant monies

received by the Montgomery County Health Department from the Indiana State Department of Health for Vector Control (Zika Funding).

(B) *Use of Funds.* All money of the 2016 Zika Grant Fund will be used, without appropriation, solely to implement the "Project" and/or to provide the services in conformance with the "Grant Agreement" entered into by and between the Indiana State Department of Health and the Montgomery County Health Department.

(C) *Non-Reverting Fund.* This is a Non-Reverting Fund."

It is further ordained that this ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.

It is further ordained that all other provisions of the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances which are not specifically amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

It is further ordained that the Montgomery County Health Department shall have the authority to implement the duties and obligations detailed in the "Grant Agreement."
