Ordinance 2016 – 29

An Ordinance Establishing the Public Health Education Program Fund

Whereas, in 2015, the Montgomery County Health Department partnered with Franciscan St. Elizabeth Health – Crawfordsville in order to conduct a Community Health Assessment; and

Whereas, this needs assessment assessed the broader scope of current health issues in Montgomery County, and this data was used to implement a Community Health Improvement Plan; and

Whereas, as part of this Community Health Improvement Plan, the Montgomery County Health Department is developing a public education program focused on the prevention of disease and promotion of quality of life initiatives; and

Whereas, the Montgomery County Health Department applied for a grant from the Montgomery County Community Foundation to assist in the funding of this public health education program, and the Foundation approved a grant in the amount of \$15,450.00 to assist in the funding of interns, equipment and advertising for the program; and

Whereas, a non-reverting fund should be created for this grant in order to facilitate the funding of this program, provide a mechanism for the deposit and administration of this grant, and allow for accounting and other compliance with the terms of the grant.

Therefore, it is ordained that a new section, Section 35.97, is hereby added to the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances establishing the Public Health Education Program Fund, and this section shall read as follows:

" § 35.97 PUBLIC HEALTH EDUCATION PROGRAM FUND

- (A) Source of Funds. The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the Public Health Education Program Fund. The fund shall consist of funds awarded to the Montgomery County Health Department by the Montgomery County Community Foundation specifically to assist in the funding of the public health education program.
- (B) Use of Funds. All money of the Public Health Education Program Fund will be used by the Montgomery County Health Department for the expenses of the public health education program, including the expenses of interns, equipment, advertising and other expenses which are consistent with the terms and conditions of the grant from the Montgomery County Community Foundation.
- (C) *Non-Reverting Fund*. This is a non-reverting fund. No portion of the monies in this Fund will revert to the Montgomery County General Fund."

It is further ordained that this ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.

It is further ordained that all other provisions of the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances which are not specifically amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
