Ordinance 2019-29

An Ordinance Establishing the 2019 IHSFG Grant Fund

Whereas, the Montgomery County Emergency Management Department applied for a Indiana Homeland Security Foundation for AEDs and equipment for the Ladoga Fire Department; and

Whereas, the Foundation has awarded a grant to Montgomery County in the amount of \$6,740.51;

Whereas, there is a need to create a fund for the deposit of these grant funds, and the Commissioners find that a new fund, the 2019 IHSFG Grant Fund, should be created in order to receive these grant funds; and

Whereas, the grant is conditioned upon the County's fulfillment of the duties, obligations, and requirements detailed in the Grant Agreement. This Agreement is attached as Exhibit A; and

Whereas, the Board of Commissioners reviewed these terms and believe it is in the best interest of Montgomery County and its citizens to perform these duties and participate in this grant; and

Therefore, it is ordained that a new section, Section 35.129, is hereby added to the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances establishing the 2019 IHSFG Grant Fund, and this section shall read as follows:

“§ 35.129 2019 IHSFG GRANT FUND

- (A) *Source of Funds.* The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the 2019 IHSFG Grant Fund. The funds shall consist of grant monies received by the Montgomery County Emergency Management Department from the Indiana Homeland Security Foundation to a grant award letter and agreement.

- (B) *Use of Funds.* All money of the 2019 IHSFG Grant Fund will be used, without appropriation, solely to implement the “Project” and/or to provide the services in conformance with the “Grant Agreement” entered into by and between the Indiana Homeland Security Foundation and the Montgomery County Emergency Management Department.

- (C) *Non-Reverting Fund.* This is a Non-Reverting Fund.”


It is further ordained that this ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.

It is further ordained that all other provisions of the Montgomery County Code of Ordinances which are not specifically amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.


It is further ordained that the Montgomery County Emergency Management Department shall have the authority to implement the duties and obligations detailed in the Grant Agreement.




