

On or about August 16, 2024, Montgomery County, with the support of its residents, intends to apply for a \$500,000 grant from the Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA) Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program. Montgomery County has allocated \$50,000 in non-CDBG general funds as a match towards this project. This grant will help establish a program to assist low-to-moderate-income residents with repair projects on their primary residences.

Under this program, eligible homeowners can receive financial assistance to cover the costs of home repairs, such as roof repairs, energy efficiency efforts, and heating and cooling improvements. No businesses or residents will be displaced as a result of this program.

A public hearing will be held on **Wednesday, August 14, at 6:30 PM** in Meeting Room A at the **Crawfordsville Public Library** to gather resident input regarding program details. Community members are encouraged to attend to learn more about the program and to provide feedback.
