#### **NEW BUSINESS**

#### Thrive West Central MOU for Grant Technical Assistance - \$45,000

The County has been awarded a \$450,000 grant from the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA) to establish and implement an Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program. MOU will authorize Thrive to assume a critical role in overseeing every aspect of the program to ensure compliance with OCRA requirements. The County has contracted with Thrive for administration and program implementation.

#### Award Bid - Thomas K. Milligan Justice Center

Montgomery County moved the Probation Department to the current location in 2009 after the State Child services vacated the building at 307 Binford Street. Prior to the move the Probation Department was housed on the third floor of the Courthouse. At the time of the relocation more space was needed for the employees of the Department. At the time of the relocation the interior was remodeled for the Department but the exterior was left existing. The current attributes of the sidewalks and steps needed to be upgraded. The County Commissioners issued a notice to bid for the ADA access improvements of the Thomas K Milligan Justice Center due back on October 28, 2024.

The engineer estimate for the project was \$216,000.00

After review it is the opinion of the Building Administrator that the bid is comprehensive and the Commissioners should accept the bid including Alternate # 1 for the ADA Access improvements for the Thomas K Milligan Justice Center

### **Open Bids for County Farm Cash Rent**

*The County has approximately 24.6 tillable acreage of real estate on the former County Farm.* 

Bid proposals shall be for a stipulated gross rent of not less than \$233.00 per tillable acre. The term of the lease will be for a three-year period beginning March 1, 2025 and ending on February 28, 2028. The lease will be for the 2025, 2026, 2027, crop years. Cash rent will be due and payable under the terms and conditions of the lease in equal installments on April 15<sup>th</sup> and November 15<sup>th</sup> each year during the term of the lease, except that the first installment will be due at the time of execution of the lease.

After preliminary bids are opened, bidders may raise their bids, a raise takes effect after the board has given written notice of that raise to the other bidders. Final bids must be submitted to the County Commissioners on or before November 25, 2024 at 8:00 a.m. Final bids will be opened by the Board on November 25, 2024 at 8:00 a.m.

#### State of Indiana Deferred Compensation Matching Plan Adoption Agreement

The Commissioners have adopted a Resolution to add a Deferred Compensation Matching Plan to the 401 A plan through Hoosier Start that is administered by Nationwide Retirement Solutions. The Deferred Compensation Adoption Agreement outlines the plan details for the Deferred Compensation Matching Plan. The agreement states that the employer will provide non matching contributions during each payroll for eligible employees. The nonmatching contribution will be 11.2% of the employee's compensation. There will not be a waiting period for eligibility. The only eligible employees for this plan are elected officials not covered by the INPRS defined benefit plan. The plan allows for contributions to account for prior years of service and the plan states that these contributions will consist of equal payments, for the person(s) who need to have it spread over more than one year. The effective date of the plan will be December 1, 2024.

#### Assessor: Updated Eagleview & Termination of Contract Eagleview Master Services Agreement

From Assessor Sherri Bentley: I am requesting that the Commissioners sign the termination of contract as the old contract is yet complete. I am also requesting the Commissioners sign a new contract with Eagleview. This is the company that flies and prepares our aerial images. The new contract includes county wide 3" (our old contract was 3" in the city and towns and 6" in rural areas) as well as change finder. Change finder compares our most recent aerial images to the new aerial images and provides me with a list of structures that do not match.

There is an additional cost for these items. I feel that these are mostly beneficial to my office. As such, I am willing to pay the additional \$14,107.94 per year out of my Reassessment budget. The departments that currently pay a portion of the annual bill will pay the same amount as they have been.

# PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING RZ2024-1 4850 W block of Fall Creek Road Ag to R-2 Residential Subdivision

Building Administrator Marc Bonwell stated, "A 6-acre parcel owned by Dwight Alex Miller for the purpose of residential development. Specifically, the petitioner requests an amendment to the zoning classification from Agriculture to R-2 for the purpose of a residential subdivision. The proposed development on the property is a subdivision for Single Family Dwellings. The existing characteristics are row crop with natural grade from North to South. The property is accessed from Fall Creek Road which is a chip seal county-maintained road in fair condition. No thoroughfare plan notes to Fall Creek road. The proposed parcel of RZ 2024-1 is five miles west of Crawfordsville using SR32 to access Fall Creek Road approximately 1.3 mile on fall Creek Road to the South. Development in the area includes parcellation for Single Family Dwellings and agricultural row crop. Adjacent property to the north is an agricultural area owned by the petitioner. West and East areas are Single Family Dwelling homesteads. South of the 6 acres is an MFG Mobile Home park. The Plan Commission moved the request to the Board of Commissioners with an unfavorable recommendation.

Board Vice President Jim Fulwider opened the Public Hearing @ 8:02 am. Dwight Miller a/k/a Father Alex Miller appeared before the Board and stated he had parishioners interested in purchasing lots to build homes close to the church on Fall Creek Road. He originally had requested the re-zone to build six homes and now he'd like to request to allow two families to build homes. Board Vice President Jim Fulwider closed the Public Hearing @ 8:08 am.

Commissioner Guard questioned Building Administrator Bonwell on what the reasonings were that the Plan Commission denied the request. Administrator Bonwell stated well depth was stated as an issue and the general thought among the citizens that appeared before the Plan Commission is they felt like 6 houses were too many houses on that parcel.

Ordinance 2024-24 Denying the Request of Dwight Alex Miller to Rezone a Certain Parcel of Land North of Fall Creek Road from Agricultural to Residential Subdivision (R-2) Commissioner Guard moved to approve Ordinance 2024-24 denying the rezone request. #### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR COLLABORATION WITH GRANT TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

This Memorandum of Understanding (this "MOU") is formed between WEST CENTRAL INDIANA ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, INC. D/B/A THRIVE WEST CENTRAL ("THRIVE") and MONTGOMERY COUNTY ("COUNTY") Commissioners.,

WHEREAS, Montgomery County received an award from Office of Community and Rural Affairs (OCRA), Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program.

WHEREAS, Montgomery County intends to utilize OCRA funds to establish and implement a countywide Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program.

WHEREAS, THRIVE provides economic and community development technical assistance, grant administration, and general support and oversight with grant funding from the Office of Community and Rural Affairs

WHEREAS, the COUNTY seeks to hire THRIVE to establish and implement the Montgomery County Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program (Program), and provide OCRA grant administrative services;

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to collaborate by the terms outlined in this MOU. NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

I. Definitions: The terms defined in the preamble have their defined meaning, and the terms below have the meaning assigned to them:

- A. "Effective Date" means September 24, 2024.
- B. "Collaborative Initiatives" means the scope of work in Section II of this MOU.

#### II. Parties' Responsibilities under this MOU

#### A. THRIVE WEST CENTRAL

I. THRIVE agrees to provide OCRA grant administration services and professional services required for the implementation of the Montgomery County Owner Occupied Rehabilitation Program.

2. THRIVE agrees to participate, either in person or digitally, in meetings and relevant informational sessions regarding information gathering for this administration.

3. THRIVE agrees to develop a list of action items, establish a timeline, and manage the administration process.

4. THRIVE agrees to work with the COUNTY to establish procedures, milestones, and a timeline for the implementation of the OOCR program.

#### B. MONTGOMERY COUNTY

1. The COUNTY agrees to invite THRIVE to participate in meetings or information sessions pertinent to the project throughout the implementation process.

2. The COUNTY agrees to assist THRIVE in program preparations by providing information regarding specific questions or sections, facilitating introductions to key program stakeholders, and demonstrating a readiness to collaborate with THRIVE in establishing and implementing a comprehensive program for the COUNTY.

3. The COUNTY agrees to work with THRIVE to establish procedures, milestones and a timeline for the implementation of the OOR program.

4.

5. The COUNTY agrees to promptly notify THRIVE of any changes, updates, or information that may impact the project.

6. The COUNTY agrees to maintain regular communication with THRIVE and provide multiple points for feedback upon request.

7. The COUNTY agrees to appoint a contact person to coordinate with THRIVE in regard to reporting, recordkeeping and expenses.

#### III. Term & Termination

This MOU shall commence on the Effective Date and continue through May 1, 2026 after which it will automatically terminate. To renew for an additional period, a meeting is required to discuss experiences, outcomes, and any modifications. Upon agreement, a new agreement will be issued. Either Party may terminate this MOU at any time and for any reason by providing at least fifteen (15) days advanced written notice to the other Party. Additional services such as labor standards, etc. require a new contract.

#### IV. Rate & Terms

Thrive staff will assume a critical role in overseeing every aspect of the program to ensure compliance with OCRA requirements. The County will contract with Thrive for administrative and program implementation services for a fee of \$45,000. Beginning October 2024 THRIVE will be paid \$7,500 on a quarterly basis through the grant period, ending the first quarter of 2026. First payment will be due January 2025.

**D. Disputes.** Any and all disputes that may arise under this MOU between the Parties shall be handled in a reasonable and respectful manner. The complaining Party shall reduce to writing its complaint and submit it to the other Party in accordance with the Notice provision above. The Parties will meet within five (5) business days of the date such complaint is received to discuss a joint resolution of the complaint.

**E. Nondiscrimination.** Neither Party, nor its subcontractors, if any, shall, in the performance of this MOU, discriminate against any Potentially Eligible Person because of her or his race, religion, color, sex, disability, national origin, ancestry, disabled veteran status, or Vietnam-era veteran status. A breach of this section shall be regarded as a material breach of this MOU.

**F. Applicable laws.** This MOU shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Indiana.

**G. Amendments.** The Parties also agree to enter into mutually acceptable modifications or amendments to this MOU as necessary to comply with applicable state and federal laws and regulations governing the activities conducted by either Party to support the Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation Program. Failure to obtain agreement on such a modification or amendment gives either Party the right to terminate this Agreement upon 15 days written notice to the other Party.

**H.** Severability. If any provision of this MOU is held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the provision shall be stricken, and all other provisions of this

#### MASTER SERVICES AGREEMENT

This Master Services Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into as of the date of last signature below (the "Effective Date") by and between the Customer identified above ("Customer") and Pictometry International Corp. dba EagleView, a corporation formed under the laws of the State of Delaware, with a place of business at 25 Methodist Hill Drive, Rochester, NY 14623 ("EagleView"). Customer and EagleView may be referred to individually as "Party" and, collectively, as "Parties." EagleView will provide the Products and Services in accordance with and subject to the conditions of this Agreement during the applicable Term.

#### GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

#### 1. DEFINITIONS

**1.1.** "Account" means an account created for Customer by EagleView for the purpose of providing access to the Products and Services.

**1.2.** "Activation" means the point in time when Customer has access to an Account and the Products and Services are available to Customer.

**1.3. "Authorized User"** means: (i) any employee or elected or appointed official of the Customer authorized by Customer to use the Products and Services; (ii) any additional users as may be defined in an Order Form (such as governmental subdivisions and their employees or elected or appointed officials) all of whom are considered to be agents of Customer for the purposes of Section 1.3; or (iii) a contractor of Customer, so long as Customer gives written notice of its intent to use such contractor to EagleView prior to being granted access to the Products and Services and, unless EagleView expressly waives such requirement for any individual, has entered into a written agreement with EagleView authorizing such access.

**1.4. "Confidential Information**" means any non-public information that is identified as or would be reasonably understood to be confidential and/or proprietary as disclosed by a Party ("Discloser") to another Party ("Recipient"). Confidential Information of EagleView includes, but is not limited to: (a) the Products and Services including any related software code and Documentation; (b) the terms of this Agreement including all Order Forms and statements of work, as applicable, and related pricing, and (c) EagleView's roadmaps, product plans, product designs, architecture, technology and technical information, security audit reviews, business and marketing plans, and business processes, however disclosed. Confidential Information will not include information that was (a) at the time of disclosure, through no fault of the Recipient, already known and generally available to the public; (b) at the time of disclosure to Recipient already rightfully known to the Recipient without any obligation of confidentiality; (c) disclosed to the Recipient by a third party who had the right to make the disclosure without any confidentiality restrictions; or (d) independently developed by the Recipient without access to or use of the Discloser's Confidential Information.

**1.5. "Documentation**" means the materials describing the features and functions of the Products and Services as may be updated from time to time by EagleView.

**1.6. "Fee"** means the fees charged by EagleView for the Products and Services as identified in an Order Form or an invoice issued by EagleView.

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**1.7. "Intellectual Property Rights"** means all worldwide intellectual property rights whether registered or unregistered including copyrights, patents, patent applications, trademarks, service marks, trade secrets, and all other proprietary rights.

**1.8. "Malware"** means any software program or code intended to harm, destroy, interfere with, corrupt, or cause undesired effects on program files, data, or other information, executable code, or application software macros.

**1.9. "Order Form"** means a mutually agreeable order signed and dated by both Parties describing the Products and Services purchased by Customer. The Parties may enter into several Order Forms with each Order Form made part of this Agreement. In the event of a conflict between the terms of this Agreement and an Order Form, the Order Form will prevail; <u>provided</u> that notwithstanding anything to the contrary, no Order Form shall exist or be effective except to the extent it is governed by this Agreement.

**1.10. "Products and Services"** means EagleView's proprietary products, services and content, whether or not identified in an Order Form, developed and owned or licensed by EagleView, its Affiliates (defined as its directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, advisors, and persons or entities which are controlled by or are under common control with EagleView), and/or their licensors.

#### 2. ACCESS AND USE OF THE PRODUCTS AND SERVICES

**2.1.** Access to the Products and Services. Subject to Customer's compliance with the terms of this Agreement, EagleView hereby grants to Customer the right to access and use the Products and Services identified on an Order Form(s) for its internal business purpose on a limited, revocable, non-exclusive, non-transferable basis in accordance with the scope of use identified in the Order Form. Unless a different term of the license grant to Products and Services is set forth in an Order Form, the right to access and use the Products and Services for its internal business purpose during the term of any Order Form(s) is the only right granted to Customer under this Agreement and any Order Form(s). EagleView will have no liability for any loss or damage arising from Customer's failure to comply with the terms of this Agreement. EagleView will provide Customer a primary administrator Account for managing and granting access to its Authorized Users. Customer will be responsible for activating Authorized Users through use of the Account. Customer and its Authorized Users are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of all passwords.

**2.2.** Access Restrictions. Access by Customer and its Authorized Users to the Products and Services is subject to the following conditions:

**2.2.1.** Customer will not access the Products and Services or Confidential Information of EagleView in a way that might adversely affect the security, stability, performance, or functions of the Products and Services.

**2.2.2.** Customer will not directly or indirectly: (a) resell or sublicense the Products and Services, (b) modify, disassemble, decompress, reverse compile, reverse assemble, reverse engineer, or translate any portion of the software related to the Products and Services; (c) create derivative works from the Products and Services; (d) use the Products and Services in violation of applicable law or the rights of others; (e) perform any vulnerability or penetration testing of the Products and Services; (f) cause harm in any way to the Products and Services or cause Malware to harm the Products and Services; (g) work around the Products and Services' technical limitations; (h) remove any proprietary notices from the Products and Services, software related to the Products and Services in order to build a competitive product or service; or (j) copy any features, functions or graphics of the software related to the Products and Services.

**2.2.3.** Customer will not use the Products and Services in connection with any data that: (a) may create a risk of harm or loss to any person or property; (b) constitutes or contributes to a crime or tort; (c) is illegal, unlawful, harmful, pornographic, defamatory, infringing, or invasive of personal privacy or publicity rights; (d) contains any information that Customer does not have the right to use; or (e) use the Products and

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Services, or any software or documentation related to the Products and Services, in violation of export control laws and regulations.

**2.2.4.** Customer and its Authorized Users shall only use the Products and Services for the use and purpose set out in this Agreement, and for no other purpose.

**2.2.5.** EagleView may suspend the Products and Services if EagleView determines, in its reasonable discretion, that suspension is necessary to protect Customer or the Products and Services from operational, security, or other material risk, or if the suspension is ordered by a court or other tribunal. In such event(s), EagleView will provide notice of suspension to Customer as soon as reasonably practicable.

**2.3.** Account Use. Customer is responsible for maintaining and keeping confidential its Account information, including passwords, usernames, and email addresses. If Customer becomes aware of: (i) any violation of the terms of this Agreement by an Authorized User or unauthorized access to an Account, or (ii) any compromise to an Account including unauthorized access to or disclosure of any Account information, passwords, usernames or login credentials, then Customer must promptly suspend any relevant access and notify EagleView.

2.4. Reservation of Rights. Except for the limited rights expressly granted herein, EagleView and its Affiliates retain all right, title and interest in all Intellectual Property Rights and technology related to EagleView's proprietary Products and Services. Customer will preserve and keep intact all EagleView copyright, patent, and/or trademark notices presented in connection with the Products and Services. Customer will not assert any implied or other rights in or to any of EagleView's Intellectual Property Rights or Products and Services. From time to time, Customer may provide suggestions, ideas, enhancement requests, or other information on its use of the Products and Services ("Feedback"). Customer agrees that EagleView will have all right, title, and interest to use such Feedback without any restrictions and without any payment or other compensation to Customer.

#### 3. PAYMENT

**3.1.** Fees. Customer will pay the Fees within thirty (30) days of receipt of invoice. EagleView will have the right to assess a late payment charge on any overdue amounts equal to the lesser of: (i) one and one-half percent (1.5%) per month, or (ii) the maximum rate allowed by applicable law. Additional or different payment terms may be set forth in the Order Form. All Fees paid pursuant to this Agreement and any applicable Order Form are non-refundable and all Products and Services ordered pursuant to an Order Form are non-cancelable, unless expressly stated to the contrary in the Order Form. In the event that EagleView seeks legal recourse for the collection of any unpaid Fees from Customer, Customer will be responsible for all of EagleView's costs of such collection action if EagleView is the prevailing party. If any Fees are overdue by more than thirty (30) days, EagleView may, without limiting its other rights and remedies, suspend the Products and Services until such amounts are paid in full, provided that, EagleView will give Customer at least ten (10) days' prior notice that its account is overdue.

**3.2. Pricing Changes.** If any Order Form is subject to renewal or extension, automatic or otherwise, EagleView may adjust the pricing for any Products and Services upon any renewal or extension of an Order Form by providing notice thereof at least ninety (90) days prior to the date for such renewal or extension.

**3.3. Taxes.** The Fees do not include any levies, duties excise, sales, use, value added or other taxes, tariffs, or duties that may apply to the Products and Services ("Taxes"). Customer is responsible for paying all Taxes associated with its purchases hereunder. If EagleView has the legal obligation to collect Taxes from Customer, Customer will pay that amount to EagleView unless Customer provides EagleView with a valid tax exemption certificate authorized by the applicable taxing authority prior to billing. For clarity, EagleView is solely responsible for taxes assessable against it based on its income, property, and employees.

#### 4. TERM AND TERMINATION

**4.1. Term.** The term of this Agreement will commence on the Effective Date and will remain in effect for so long as there exists an open Order Form and for a period of twelve (12) months thereafter ("Term"). After expiration or early termination, Customer will not have any access to content or any Products and Services.

**4.2. Termination; Suspension.** Either Party may terminate this Agreement or any Order Form upon written notice to the other Party if: (i) the non-terminating Party materially breaches this Agreement or any Order Form and fails to cure such breach within thirty (30) days of delivery of written notice; or (ii) if the other Party becomes the subject of a petition in bankruptcy or any other proceeding relating to insolvency, receivership, liquidation, or assignment for the benefit of creditors. EagleView may suspend access to the Products and Services in the event Customer is in material breach of this Agreement and such breach has not been cured within thirty (30) days' written notice to Customer. In the event of suspension due to Customer's material breach of this Agreement, Customer will remain liable for all Fees applicable to the Term that would have been paid had access to the Products and Services not been suspended.

**4.3.** Effect of Termination on Fees: EagleView Breach. In the event this Agreement is terminated by Customer for a material breach by EagleView, (a) where EagleView has fully delivered imagery to Customer, no refund of fees will be made, or (b) where Customer, at the time of termination, is accessing on-line imagery and data access and/or software related to any Products and Services, EagleView will refund any unused prorated, prepaid fees for the Products and Services.

**4.4.** Effect of Termination on Fees: Customer Breach. In the event this Agreement is terminated by EagleView for a material breach by Customer or due to section 4.2 (ii) applying, Customer will be responsible for all Fees and Taxes under any current Order Form(s).

**4.5. Survival.** Upon any expiration or termination of any Order Form or this Agreement, the following sections will survive with respect thereto: 2.4 (Reservation of Rights), 3 (Payment), 5 (Confidentiality), 7 (Indemnification), 8 (Limitation of Liability), and 9 (General Provisions).

#### 5. CONFIDENTIALITY

**5.1. Obligations.** Each Party will hold the other Party's Confidential Information in confidence with at least as much care as it holds its own Confidential Information, and neither Party will disclose any of the other Party's Confidential Information to any third party. Each Party may use the Confidential Information solely for purposes of its performance under this Agreement, and may disclose such information to its employees, subcontractors and professional advisors only on a need-to-know basis, provided that such employees, subcontractors and professional advisors are bound by obligations of confidentiality at least as restrictive as those set forth in this Agreement.

**5.2. Required Disclosure.** The Recipient may disclose Confidential Information as required by court order, Freedom of Information Act request, or otherwise by law, provided that it gives the Discloser prior written notice of such disclosure (to the extent legally permitted) as well as reasonable assistance if Discloser seeks a protective order to prevent the disclosure. Any disclosure pursuant to this Section 5.2 will be restricted to include the least amount of Confidential Information necessary to comply with the law or order. All costs incurred by the Recipient in connection with complying with such order will be paid solely by the Recipient.

#### 6. WARRANTIES

**6.1. Mutual Warranties.** Each Party represents and warrants to the other Party that: (i) it is an organization duly organized, validly existing and in good standing under the laws of the jurisdiction of its formation, has all requisite power and authority to carry on its business and to own and operate its properties and assets; and (ii) the individual signing this Master Services Agreement and any Order Forms has the requisite authority to bind the party to this Agreement and the Order Form, respectively.

**6.2. EagleView Warranty.** EagleView warrants that (i) it will provide the Products and Services with commercially reasonable care and skill; and (ii) the Products and Services will conform to the then-current Documentation in all material respects. In the event of a breach of this warranty, Customer's sole and exclusive remedy will be as described in Section 4.3 Payments Upon Termination.

**6.3. Disclaimer.** EXCEPT FOR EXPRESS WARRANTIES SET FORTH IN THIS AGREEMENT, EAGLEVIEW MAKES NO ADDITIONAL REPRESENTATION OR WARRANTY OF ANY KIND, WHETHER

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EXPRESS, IMPLIED IN FACT OR BY OPERATION OF LAW, OR STATUTORY, AS TO ANY MATTER WHATSOEVER. EAGLEVIEW EXPRESSLY DISCLAIMS ALL IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY, FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE AND NON-INFRINGEMENT. EAGLEVIEW DOES NOT WARRANT THAT THE PRODUCTS AND SERVICES (INCLUDING ANY SUPPORT SERVICES) WILL BE ERROR FREE, WILL MEET CUSTOMER'S REQUIREMENTS, OR WILL BE TIMELY OR SECURE. CUSTOMER WILL NOT HAVE THE RIGHT TO MAKE OR PASS ON ANY REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTY ON BEHALF OF CUSTOMER TO ANY THIRD PARTY. TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, THE PRODUCTS AND SERVICES AND SUPPORT SERVICES ARE PROVIDED "AS IS."

#### 7. INDEMNIFICATION

**7.1. EagleView Indemnification.** EagleView will defend Customer against any claim, demand, suit or proceeding made by a third party alleging that the Products and Services infringes the intellectual property rights of such third party and will pay all costs or damages that are finally awarded by a court of competent jurisdiction (including reasonable attorneys' fees) or agreed to in a written settlement signed by EagleView; <u>provided</u>, <u>however</u>, that Customer will: (i) notify EagleView in writing within ten (10) calendar days of its receipt of notice of the claim, (ii) give EagleView sole control of the defense and settlement of the claim (except that EagleView will not settle any claim that results in liability or an admission of liability by Customer without Customer's prior written consent), and (iii) provide EagleView with all reasonable assistance, information, and authority necessary to perform EagleView's obligations under this paragraph. Notwithstanding the foregoing, EagleView will have no liability for any claim of infringement or misappropriation to the extent such claim arises from: (i) use of the Products and Services in combination with materials including software, hardware, or content not furnished by EagleView; or (ii) Customer's breach of this Agreement.

**7.2. Remedies.** In the event the Products and Services are held or is believed by EagleView to infringe or misappropriate any Intellectual Property Rights of a third party, EagleView will have the option, at its expense, to: (i) replace the Products and Service with a non-infringing equivalent, (ii) modify the Products and Services to be non-infringing, (iii) obtain for Customer a license to continue using the Products and Services; or (iv) terminate this Agreement or any relevant Order Form and refund any prepaid, prorated fees for the remainder of the Term. The foregoing remedies constitute Customer's sole and exclusive remedies and EagleView's sole liability with respect to any third-party infringement claim.

**7.3. Customer Indemnification.** Customer will, at its expense, defend EagleView from and against all third party claims and will pay any costs, losses or damages that are finally awarded (including reasonable attorneys' fees) or agreed to in settlement to the extent arising out of Customer's breach of this Agreement, provided that (i) EagleView notifies Customer in writing within ten (10) calendar days of its receipt of written notice of the claim, (ii) Customer has sole control of the defense and settlement of the claim (except that Customer will not settle any claim that results in liability or an admission of liability by EagleView without EagleView's prior written consent), and (iii) EagleView provides Customer with all reasonable assistance, information, and authority necessary to perform Customer's obligations under this paragraph.

#### 8. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

**8.1. Consequential Damages.** TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, IN NO EVENT WILL EITHER PARTY OR ITS AFFILIATES BE LIABLE TO THE OTHER FOR ANY INDIRECT, INCIDENTAL, CONSEQUENTIAL, COVER, BUSINESS INTERRUPTION, SPECIAL, OR PUNITIVE DAMAGES OF ANY KIND OR NATURE, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, LOSS OF USE, DATA, PROFITS, REVENUE, OR GOODWILL, WHETHER AN ACTION IS BASED IN CONTRACT, TORT, OR OTHERWISE, REGARDLESS OF WHETHER EITHER PARTY HAS BEEN ADVISED OF THE POSSIBILITY OF SUCH DAMAGES.

**8.2.** Limitation of Liability. EXCLUDING EITHER PARTY'S INDEMNIFICATION OBLIGATIONS PURSUANT TO SECTION 7, TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, THE AGGREGATE AND CUMULATIVE LIABILITY OF EITHER PARTY INCLUDING ALL THEIR AFFILIATES REGARDLESS OF THE FORM OF ACTION, WHETHER IN CONTRACT OR TORT (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO

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NEGLIGENCE) WILL IN NO EVENT EXCEED THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FEES PAID AND PAYABLE BY CUSTOMER IN THE TWELVE MONTHS PRECEDING THE ACTIONS GIVING RISE TO THE CLAIM.

#### 9. GENERAL PROVISIONS

**9.1. Export Laws.** The Products and Services and derivatives thereof may be subject to export laws and regulations of the United States and other jurisdictions. EagleView and Customer each represent that it is not named on any U.S. government denied-party list. Customer will not permit any user to access, use, export, reexport, or transfer, directly or indirectly, any Products and Services or content in a U.S.-embargoed country or region (including but not limited to Cuba, Iran, North Korea, Sudan, Syria, Crimea, or Russia) or in violation of any U.S. export law or regulation.

**9.2.** No Third-Party Beneficiaries. Except as specifically identified in this Agreement, nothing in this Agreement is intended to confer upon any person other than the Parties and their respective successors or permitted assigns, any rights, remedies, obligations, or liabilities whatsoever.

**9.3. Independent Contractors.** Nothing contained in this Agreement will be deemed or construed as creating a joint venture or partnership between any of the Parties hereto. Neither Party will have the power or authority to control the activities or operations of the other. At all times, the status of the Parties will be that of independent contractors.

**9.4.** Force Majeure. Except with respect to Customer's payment obligations, each Party will be excused from performance under this Agreement, will not be deemed to be in breach hereof, and will have no liability to the other Party whatsoever if either party is prevented from performing any of its obligations hereunder, in whole or in part, as a result of a Force Majeure Event. A "Force Majeure Event" means an event or occurrence beyond the control of the nonperforming Party, such as an act of God or of the public enemy, embargo or other act of government in either its sovereign or contractual capacity, government regulation, travel ban or request, court order, civil disturbance, terrorism, war, quarantine restriction, epidemic, virus, fire, weather, flood, accident, strike, slowdown, delay in transportation, electrical power outage, interruption or degradation in electronic communications systems, inability to obtain necessary labor, materials or manufacturing facilities, and other similar events. In the event of any delay resulting from a Force Majeure Event, any date of delivery hereunder will be extended for a period equal to the time lost because of the delay.

**9.5. The unenforceability of any provision of this Agreement will not affect the validity of the remaining provisions hereof. A waiver by either Party of a breach or failure to perform hereunder will not constitute a waiver of any subsequent breach or failure.

WHEREAS, having considered the recommendation of the County Highway Department, the Board now finds that the speed limit for County Road 500 North between the eastern town limits of Darlington and State Road 47 should be reduced to 30 miles per hour; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDAINED by the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners that, effective immediately, the speed limit on County Road 500 North between the eastern town limits of Darlington and State Road 47 is 30 miles per hour.

## AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE 2025 MONTGOMERY COUNTY FAMILY RECOVERY COURT GRANT FUND

Whereas, the Montgomery County Family Recovery Court has been awarded a grant on behalf of the 2025 Opioid Settlement Grant in the amount of \$9,000 to be used for Travel and Barrier Busters for participants of Montgomery County Family Recovery Court; and

Whereas, the use of funds from the grant award may be used by the Montgomery County Family Recovery Court consistent with the terms and conditions of the grant award and grant agreement; and

Whereas, the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners finds that a new fund, the 2025 Montgomery County Family Recovery Court Grant Fund, should be created in order to receive the funds from the 2025 Opioid Settlement Fund and to provide a mechanism for appropriation and accounting for the funds used.

Therefore, it is ordained that a new section, Section 35.\_\_\_\_ of the Montgomery County Code, is hereby added to the County Code and that this new section shall read as follows:

#### "§ 35.\_\_\_\_ 2025 Montgomery County Family Recovery Court Grant Fund

(A) *Source of Funds.* The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the 2025 Montgomery County Family Recovery Court Grant Fund. The fund shall consist of monies received on behalf of the 2025 Opioid Settlement Funds.

(B) Use of Funds. All money in the Fund will be used by Montgomery County Probation Department from the 2025 Opioid Grant Fund for support of the Family Recovery Court and will provide funding specifically \$5,000 for travel and \$4,000 for Barrier Busters for participants as provided for in the grant award, in a form and manner consistent with the award.

(C) Non-Reverting Fund. This is a Non-Reverting Fund."

It is further ordained that this ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.

It is further ordained that all other provisions of the Montgomery County

Code of Ordinances which are not specifically amended by this ordinance shall

remain in full force and effect.

## AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE 2025 MONTGOMERY COUNTY DRUG COURT PROGRAM GRANT FUND

Whereas, the Montgomery County Drug Court has been awarded a grant on behalf of the 2025 Opioid Settlement Grant in the amount of \$10,000 to be used for Travel/Training and Barrier Buster Supplies/Services for participants of Montgomery County Drug Court Program; and

Whereas, the use of funds from the grant award may be used by the Montgomery County Drug Court Program consistent with the terms and conditions of the grant award and grant agreement; and

Whereas, the Montgomery County Board of Commissioners finds that a new fund, the 2025 Montgomery County Drug Court Program Grant Fund, should be created in order to receive the funds from the 2025 Opioid Settlement Fund and to provide a mechanism for appropriation and accounting for the funds used.

Therefore, it is ordained that a new section, Section 35.\_\_\_\_ of the Montgomery County Code, is hereby added to the County Code and that this new section shall read as follows:

#### "§ 35.\_\_\_\_ 2025 Montgomery County Drug Court Program Grant Fund

(A) Source of Funds. The Montgomery County Board of Commissioners hereby establishes the 2025 Montgomery County Drug Court Program Grant Fund. The fund shall consist of monies received on behalf of the 2025 Opioid Settlement Funds.

(B) Use of Funds. All money in the Fund will be used by Montgomery County Probation Department from the 2025 Opioid Grant Fund for support of the Drug Court Program and will provide funding specifically \$5,000 for travel/training and \$5,000 for Barrier Buster Supplies/Services for participants as provided for in the grant award, in a form and manner consistent with the award.

(C) Non-Reverting Fund. This is a Non-Reverting Fund."

It is further ordained that this ordinance shall be effective upon adoption.

It is further ordained that all other provisions of the Montgomery County

Code of Ordinances which are not specifically amended by this ordinance shall

remain in full force and effect.

On behalf of the Opioid Settlement Fund Leadership Team, we want to inform you that after careful consideration by the grant review team, your request was presented to the County Commissioners and received approval. These funds will be disbursed to you prior to the end of the year. At that time, you will receive a contract with all the conditions for the grant.

Funds are to be used as presented in your application, to assist participants with removing barriers to their success in recovery from addiction. Most participants beginning Drug Court have just been released from incarceration, which usually results in having a lack of funds and other resources. The funds being requested would be used to purchase 2 bikes with additional accessories such as headlights, brake lights, and other safety equipment, to assist with lack of available transportation. The funding would also be used to purchase cellphones with 30-day data plan so the participant can call probation to schedule drug tests, contact treatment places to engage in and look for employment. They are also requesting them to pay for housing assistance. Also, these funds will be available to help with treatment expenses. Another part of these funds will be used for drug screen costs.
