

Montgomery County awarded \$1.5 million in State grant

for paving roads.

(March 7, 2025) Montgomery County has been awarded a \$1.5 million Community Crossing Matching Grant from the State. The grant, which follows a 75%-25% state-local matching structure, will be supplemented by \$775,000 in county funds, bringing the estimated total project cost to \$2,275,000.

The funding will be used for a Cape Seal pavement preservation project, a process that applies a chip seal with a micro surface to extend the lifespan of paved county roads and improve driving conditions. This cost-effective treatment will enhance road durability while reducing long-term maintenance costs. The county has received over \$7 million dollars from the Community Crossing Matching Grant program since 2016.
